"Most organisations assume their environments are under control because their core system is secured. In reality, without a single pane of glass view of all of their SaaS & AI applications, companies are much more likely to be hacked, especially through suppliers".

Attackers no longer need to break in. They use access that already exists, through external connections, over-permissioned accounts, or compromised credentials.
